MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

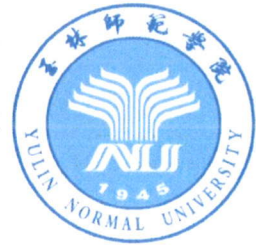
Rajamangala University of Technology Tawan-ok

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is signed between Yulin Normal University, the People's Republic of China by Professor Wang Zhuohua, Ph.D., the President, and Rajamangala University of Technology Tawan-ok, Thailand by Associate Professor Rerkchai Fooprateepsiri, Ph.D., the President. These two universities (parties) wish to have academic cooperation in the areas of their mutual interests.

Objectives:


1. To enhance the academic capability and the internationalization approach.
2. To perform the cooperation within the areas of academic, research, and development.
3. To enhance the credibility and the confidence of the two universities in public and among private sectors through the international cooperation.
4. To strengthen the potential of the lecturers and researchers to meet international standards.

The two parties hereby have been accepted each other as follows:

1. Scope of the cooperated activities
 - 1.1 Joint research
 - 1.2 Collaborative exchange of researchers and lecturers
 - 1.3 Student exchange
2. For the implementation of the MOU, both parties will delegate each other's representatives to have an agreement in detail in a form of documents attached.
3. The MOU may be updated to become more appropriate under the approval of both parties. A notification sent to the other party is not less than 30 (thirty) days in order to consider it together. Any amendments shall be made. Then, a document attached has to be signed by the authorized one, and it is counted as part of this MOU.
4. The term of this MOU is 5 years, starting from the date on it. Both parties may extend the time by another official document, and the extension is part of the MOU.

5. Cancellation of the MOU may be done when one party inform the other by a document at least 90 days before the time of the cancellation. It affects when two parties agree. After that, all MOU documents attached are also cancelled. Such abolition will not affect the cooperation that is running or pending at that moment.
6. Any cooperation under this MOU has no legal obligation.

The MOU is formed in two original versions with an exactly similar context for each party. Then, both parties read and understand all messages throughout it. Finally, the MOU is signed and stamped (if any) in the presence of witnesses.






